Summary of Discussion

Dr. Vikas Gupta started the meeting with the permission of Committee Members. He also introduces all members of Governing body and invitee member. Dr. Raghvendra Kumar Khadle start discussion on various agendas.

Agenda- 01: Review the Minutes of first Academic Council Meeting

Resolution: *The Minutes of the First Academic Council Meeting were reviewed in detail. All agenda items were discussed thoroughly with the Council members and invitee members. After due deliberation and discussions all the agenda items were unanimously approved. The Minutes are hereby confirmed and approved.*

Agenda-02: Approval of scheme and syllabi recommended by Board of Studies (BOS) for first year (2025-26 admitted batch) of the following programs which have been taught to the students after the recommendation from duly constituted BOS of following courses: -

- Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.)
- Master of Technology (M.Tech.)
- Master of computer application (M.C.A.)

Suggestion:- Scheme and syllabi of first year recommended by BOS (August 2025) were discussed by committee members with the following suggestions:-

Prof. Arun Prakash raised a query regarding the inclusion of core subjects such as Basic Mechanical Engineering, Basic Electrical & Electronics Engineering, and Engineering Mechanics in the First Year syllabus. During the discussion, it was clarified that these subjects develop the foundation required to study various discipline of Engineering. These basic blocks help students to develop basic engineering concepts, analytical skills, and interdisciplinary understanding, which are essential for advanced and branch-specific subjects in subsequent semesters. It was further emphasized that early exposure to these core subjects enables students to bridge the gap between theory and practical engineering applications, improves problem-solving ability, and aligns the curriculum with national academic standards and regulatory guidelines.

After detailed discussion, all members and invitee members expressed no objection, and the Council unanimously agreed to include the core subjects in the First Year syllabus.

Prof. Neeraj Mishra: - Suggested that the member secretary of Academic Council should present the percentage-wise distribution of credits across various course categories such as Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS), Basic Sciences (BSC), Professional Core Courses, Professional Elective Courses, Project Work, and other relevant components.

Also addition of percentage-wise distribution of credit would enhance transparency, curriculum balance, and compliance with regulatory guidelines, and facilitate a better understanding of the overall credit structure of the academic program.

Resolution: - *All the members of academic council were agreed with the suggestion and after detailed discussion the Scheme and Syllabi of the First Year were approved. All the members shown satisfaction about the teaching with new syllabus and scheme.*



Agenda-03

Approval of schemes recommended by Board of studies (BOS) for higher semester. (III Semester onwards) of the following programs.

- Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.)
- Master of Technology (M.Tech.)
- Master of computer application (M.C.A)

Suggestion:

Dr. Archana Choudhary and Dr. R. M. Sarviya suggested that:

- In B.Tech 7th and 8th Semesters, NPTEL/MOOC courses may be added/included under Pre-Placement Training to compensate for the credits of compulsory core subjects.
- In M.Tech and MCA programs, Internship/Training from Research Institutes or Workshops may be incorporated in the scheme.
- The syllabus of all UG and PG programmes for the 3rd and 4th semesters shall be framed and finalized by the respective Boards of Studies (BOS) and made available well in advance, before the commencement of the new academic session..

Resolution:

The scheme of the B.Tech, M.Tech, and MCA programmes of higher semester (III Semester onwards), as recommended by the Board of Studies (BOS), is approved by the Academic Council (AC) along with the suggestions put forward by Dr. Archana Choudhary and Dr. R. M. Sarviya. It is further resolved that the syllabi for the 3rd and 4th semesters of all UG and PG programmes shall be finalized and approved by the respective BOS prior to the commencement of the new academic session

Agendra-04:-

Review and approval of Academic calendar.

Resolution:

The Academic Council (AC) reviewed and approved the Academic Calendar. All members suggested that the changes in Academic Calendar (if any) should be displayed on the Institute website for wider dissemination. It was also resolved that vacation periods and semester breaks must be clearly mentioned in the Academic Calendar.

Discussion on the approval of forthcoming end sem examination for the Session 2025-26 Admitted students (all courses) proposed to be conducted from Feb. 2026.

Suggestion:

Dr. Archana Choudhary suggested that the question paper pattern for the forthcoming examinations should be aligned with the AICTE model question papers and should strictly adhere to Bloom's Taxonomy to ensure appropriate assessment of learning outcomes.



Resolution:

The Academic Council (AC) discussed the matter and approved the conduction of forthcoming examinations for the Session 2025–26 admitted students. It was resolved that the question paper pattern will be in accordance with AICTE model guidelines and shall strictly follow Bloom's Taxonomy for all programs. Council approved the proposal for the forthcoming end sem examination for the Session 2025-26 Admitted students (all courses) to be conducted from Feb. 2026.
